Check In Procedure:

1. All students will exit buses and unload luggage only. When it's announced, students will go to their appointed chaperone (list will be provided to members electronically **via Remind and Google Classroom**).
2. Chaperones will gather students and luggage in one area and wait for Mr. Mauriello to meet with Mr. Coppola.
3. Mr. Coppola will have already divided up all the room keys accordingly. He will write the room numbers of all students on the master room sheet and get copies made for the entire staff/chaperones. He will give each chaperone their students' room keys to distribute.
4. Next, students will receive room keys and be notified of their room number by their respective chaperone.
5. All students and staff will then bring luggage to room and chaperones will check their assigned rooms for problems after getting acclimated.

Check Out Procedure - all done between 9:45am-10:15am:

1. All students will pack your luggage and clean your room.

2. Place all luggage outside your room. Your room should be spotless — **no garbage!**

3. Wait to be dismissed by your chaperone. They won't dismiss you until your room is spotless.

4. Give them your room keys when you are approved for dismissal.

5. After you're dismissed, you may bring luggage to the buses. Uniforms and instruments should be on the buses already.

Rules and Consequences

Infractions

- #1. Alcohol/Drugs/Smoking/Vaping
- #2. Girl in boy's room or boy in girl's room
- #3. Pranks: improper behavior, in another in another room uninvited, "hands-off" others properties

- #5. Student out-of-bounds

Out of Bounds (violating any of the following)

This is a school sponsored event, therefore smoking or vaping is not allowed at any time on this trip. Remain seated on the bus. Music players must be used with headphones. Be considerate of other guests in the hotel.

- TV, music, and voice at minimum volume
- Do not run in the hallway
- Do not jump on the furniture
- Do not deface hotel property (roommates will be billed)
- Do not remove hotel property (roommates will be billed)
- Rooms must be in order at all times.
- Students may not use the hotel room phones or make any charges to their room; cable TV, room service, etc.
- Do not slam hotel room doors

*All school field trip rules remain in effect during the trip. Chaperones will **knock and search** any student's room if necessary to enforce all school rules and regulations. Chaperones also reserve the right to **check any beverage carriers**, containers, or mini coolers at any time during the trip.

Other Rules on the Hershey Trip

Courtesy, Behavior, and Restaurants: Remember, the possibility of future trips will be determined by the actions of the entire group in terms of cleanliness, behavior, and courtesy. Clean the areas at restaurants. Be aware of people around you.

Phone Emergency Number: Mr. Mauriello's cell phone works in Hershey. Call him in case of an emergency. Phones will be on at all times.

Behavior at the Hotel: Be aware of people in the hotel. Do not act loud or behave in a fashion that will disturb others. **Be on super special behavior after 9pm.** One phone call to the front desk will hurt our reputation and the possibility of returning to this hotel.

The Long Ride, getting to the Hotel, etc: The bus ride is long so you must be courteous to all those on the bus. Behavior is to be exemplary at all times. Any problems or possible confrontations should be brought to the attention of a chaperone immediately. When we get to the hotel you must be patient as it takes us some time to actually check in.

Rules During Trip. You have agreed to a set of standards for the Roslyn School District to be a part of this trip. Please note, **students will be sent home at parents expense** if they are found with or using alcohol or drugs. This rule is strictly adhered to.

Parents Picking Up Students: Parents who are in Hershey **will not** be allowed to take students from the band trip at any time. This would make it impossible for us to keep track of all band members. However, parents are encouraged to eat with us or be with the students at any of our venues.

Hazing: No hazing of any type will be tolerated.

Punctuality: Do not be late for anything. Those late will be grounded. **When you are late it causes us to make meeting times earlier which in effect take away hours of free time.**

If you are sick, you must tell us! See the nurse immediately.

Allowed on the trip: Nintendo Switch and any other **handheld** video games are ok. Any portable music players with headphones are ok.

Not Allowed on the trip: Televisions of any kind, portable televisions and DVD players will not be allowed at all; No video game systems that have separate controllers and/or separate televisions hooked up to them. **Absolutely no external speaker music systems allowed. No other unauthorized electronics either.**

Chaperone Instructions

Room Assignments: All staff members will be sleeping in rooms near their assigned students' rooms, not with the students. We will determine where the rooms are when we check into the hotel.

General Chaperoning During the Day: We are chaperoning and monitoring the students at all times in a passive way. Keep looking around and noticing everything. Report any problems to Mr. Mauriello immediately. You need to simply walk around and keep your eyes open at all times.

Medical Problems/Sick Students: All medical problems go to the nurse.

Student Wake Up & Lights Out: Chaperones will be responsible for their students, waking them up in the morning and checking their rooms at night. Chaperones will be assigned to rooms.

Monitoring: Supervise students when you are on duty, walk around or sit and relax at a good vantage point where you can see the most students.

Chaperone Meetings: We will meet throughout the day to discuss any problems or concerns you have. We are a team of professionals and must work together to solve any problems as they arise.

Be proactive. Any small problems or attitude problems from students will quickly escalate. Do not tolerate any dirty looks or attitude problems from anyone. Bring any of these types of problems to the attention of Mr. Mauriello immediately.

Our Expectations: Always Keep the students in check with a proper positive attitude. We expect it in the band program, and they all know the expectations.

Emergency Problems/Attitude Problems: If there are any situations which arise in which you are uncomfortable, please involve Mr. Mauriello immediately.

Overnight Supervision: A security guard will be on duty each night from 11pm until 6am. **Any chaperone assignment switches must be cleared by Mr. Mauriello** prior to the switch time. We need to know where the chaperones are at all times.

Smoking/Vaping is Not Permitted: Under no circumstances should any student be smoking/vaping at any time. Students caught smoking will be dealt with swiftly and strictly. Notify Mr. Mauriello of any violators. This is a school trip, and no smoking is allowed.
